Each class is geared for the child's age. They will find and develop their own style while working in a medium that's comfortable for them. Beginning students are taught the basics of drawing, which is the foundation for all fine art work. Skills such as perspective, color and texture will be worked on so that the students can create interest and depth within their art. These budding young artists will be encouraged to tackle both realistic and stylized art in a relaxed and fun atmosphere. As the student becomes acclimated to the pencil, he or she will be introduced to other fine art media. This includes colored pencil, pen and ink, pastel (oil or chalk), watercolor, acrylic and oil. All classes are taught one-on-one; students are asked to feel free to bring in some examples of art that they recently completed so that the instructor can be made aware of each students' level, needs and expectations.
